TÉRMS Y CONDICIONES

The Adventist University of Antilles, counts with two dorms for ladies and one dorm for gentlemen. About a third of our students live inside the properties of our institution. For this reason, the availability of spaces in the dorms are limited, is very important that you follow the instructions provided to avoid the denial of your dorm application or the process stopped because of lack of information and documents. In the next page there will be information regarding the requirements and documents needed to be accepted to the dorms. Please read carefully.

REQUIREMENTS

To be a resident in the dorms of the Adventist University of Antilles, the applicant must:

1. Be single and less than 25 years of age
2. Accepted as a regular student in our institution
3. Completed and send the DORM APPLICATION with all the documents requested
4. Maintain each semester a twelve (12) credits or more for the sections **FA** and **SP**; at least three (3) credits for the sections **SU1** and **SU2**.

Clave: **SU1** = Academic Session from July to August
FA = Academic Session from August to December
SP = Academic Session from January to May
SU2 = Academic Session from May to June

PROCESS TO FOLLOW

To speed up the process of your application, you must bring the following:

- **DORM APPLICATION**
 - a. Note: You must avoid leaving information incomplete for it will delay the process of such.
- **Pay a deposit of \$100.00.** The receipt must be adjoined with the DORM APPLICATION. The deposit can be submitted through mail by a Money Order or a personal check. You can also contact our Cashier Office; telephone number is 787-834-9595 ext. 2202, to make the payment on credit or debit cards such as: VISA, Master Card, Discovery, American Express and ATM.
- **Good Conduct Certificate** (applicants older than 18 years of age)
- **(2) photos 2x2 passport type**

Once you bring all the documents previously mentioned, then, we will process your application.

NOTE:

1. Incomplete applications will not be processed
2. Completing the application and bringing all the documents does NOT guarantee the acceptance of such.
3. Also, receiving the letter of acceptance to enroll in our university does not mean you are automatically accepted into our dorms. If approved to the dorms, you will receive a letter of acceptance from the Vice-President of Student Affairs.

CANCELATION

If you wish to cancel your DORM APPLICATION, you must fill out the CANCELATION FORM (VPAE-DF-04) and bring it personally, by fax to 787-834-9597, or by e-mail to studentaffaris@uaa.edu. The amount of **\$100.00** will be **100% refunded** if the process of cancellation was made fourteen (14) days before the semester, in which applied, starts. Also, if the student was **not accepted** the **deposited amount will also be refunded**.
